Permit Conditions. *(The conditions listed on this Permit supersede all previous Permit conditions.)*

- A: The permit holder must operate in full compliance with federal, state and local solid waste management statutes, regulations, ordinances and codes.
- B: The permit holder must operate in accordance with the solid waste management permit application and the approved operations/procedures plan, as submitted to the Washoe County Health District. Any changes to the approved application and/or the operations/procedures plan must be reviewed and approved by the Washoe County Health District prior to implementation.
- C: Washoe County Health District staff will conduct routine inspections of the permit holder's operation and reserves the right to enter the property at any time during hours of operation to review and evaluate solid waste management practices and record keeping.
- D: **This permit is not transferable.**
- E: **This permit may be suspended or revoked for failure to comply with any of the conditions specified.**

Additional Conditions: *(may continue on reverse)*

- 1: The permit holder must document and maintain records for load checking and waste screening activities; said documentation must be maintained for a minimum of one (1) year and must be made available for review by the Washoe County Health District upon request.
- 2: The permit holder must obtain approval from the Washoe County Health District prior to accepting any waste / recyclable material not specified by this permit.
- 3: This facility is approved to accept and process the following waste streams: metal, cardboard, wood, yard debris / green waste, concrete, asphalt, plastic, construction and demolition debris. Incoming loads must not contain more than 10% dirt /soil by weight or volume.
- 4: All special wastes and hazardous wastes must be separate from any recycled or recovered materials. Special wastes and hazardous wastes are required to be handled per the approved operations plan and the Washoe county District Board of Health Regulations Governing Solid Waste Management.
- 5: Nevada Recycling and Salvage, Ltd dba Green Solutions Recycling must submit an annual report with total volumes in tons of material recycled the previous calendar year by February 1st.
- 6: The permit holder must submit a quarterly report for each calendar quarter by the 15th of the following month. This report must detail the volume of materials being accepted at the facility, the volumes of approved recyclable materials recovered and the volume of waste transported from the facility for landfilling or other final disposal.
